



# Da Nang – Hoi An 2 Days Tour



## Day 1: Da Nang City Tour

### Schedule



9:00AM – Linh Ung Pagoda

Ascend to the most magnificent of Danang's three Linh Ung pagodas, perched on Son Tra Peninsula. Stand in awe before the 67-meter-tall Lady Buddha statue, a serene sentinel offering panoramic views of the endless East Sea. The sprawling grounds blend spiritual architecture with the raw beauty of the coastline.

### Travel Tips

- Dress modestly (shoulders & knees covered). The marble courtyard can be hot and reflective—sunglasses are a must.
- Don't just visit the statue. Explore the hall behind it for intricate dragon mosaics and a quieter, shaded garden area.



9:30AM – Coffee Time  
(Son Tra Marine)

Enjoy a premium coffee experience at the sophisticated Son Tra Marina. Sip your brew while overlooking a serene bay filled with yachts, with the majestic Son Tra Mountain providing a dramatic green backdrop—a moment of luxury and tranquility..



### Travel Tips

- This upscale venue offers a refined atmosphere. Your guide will assist with ordering from their selection of Vietnamese and international coffee styles.
- For the best experience, try their signature "Marina Blend" coffee and step outside to the waterfront terrace for the most impressive views.

## Day 1: Da Nang City Tour

### Schedule



10:00AM – Rooftop + My Khe Beach

Capture Danang's modern skyline against its natural beauty from a chic urban rooftop. Then, descend to feel the powder-soft, white sands of Mỹ Khê Beach—voted by Forbes as one of the most attractive beaches on the planet—at your feet.

#### Travel Tips

- At the beach, rent a lounge (usually very cheap) from one of the vendors to have a "home base" for your belongings and shade.
- The sun is intense. Apply waterproof sunscreen liberally before leaving the hotel, and reapply after swimming.



11:30AM – Lunch (Luk Lak Restaurant)

Delve into the heart of Central Vietnamese cuisine at Luk Lak Restaurant, famous for its modern take on local classics. Enjoy dishes like Mì Quảng or Bánh Xèo in a stylish, contemporary setting.

#### Travel Tips

- Don't miss their signature "Luk Lak" beef cubes, a Vietnamese take on a seared steak dish.
- A set menu featuring regional specialties will be prepared for the group, ensuring a seamless and delicious dining experience.



# Da Nang – Hoi An 2 Days Tour

## Day 1: Da Nang City Tour

### Schedule



1:00PM Cồn Market/ Hàn Market

Immerse yourself in the vibrant, sensory-packed world of a local Vietnamese market. Hàn Market is a multi-story icon for everything from dried goods to silk, while Cồn Market offers a more raw, ground-level local experience.



#### Travel Tips

- Wear secure bags (cross-body) and be mindful of your pockets in crowded aisles.
- Bargaining is expected for non-food items. Start at about 50-60% of the asking price, negotiate with a smile, and be prepared to walk away.



2:30PM – Marble Mountain

Explore the five mystical Marble Mountains (Ngũ Hành Sơn), each representing a natural element. Climb stone staircases into cavernous Buddhist sanctuaries, discover hidden pagodas, and be rewarded with sweeping views from the peaks.

#### Travel Tips

- Wear sturdy, non-slip shoes. The stairs can be steep, uneven, and slippery in caves.
- There is an elevator (for a small fee) to a high platform on Thủy Mountain. Use it to save energy for exploring the caves and pagodas.

**5:30PM – Dinner**  
(Donald Trung)

Dine at this uniquely named venue offering a diverse menu of Vietnamese dishes. Its prime location near the Dragon Bridge provides a great prelude to the evening's festivities.

#### Travel Tips

- A group table with a view will be reserved. This restaurant caters well to a variety of tastes.
- Save room for dessert later, as we have a special sweet treat planned to end the day!



**7:00PM Dragon Bridge + Love Bridge**

Stroll across the romantic Love Bridge to see the magnificent, fire-breathing Dragon Bridge.



#### Travel Tips

- The best views of the fire-breathing are from the sidewalks of the bridge itself or the cafes along the east bank of the river.
- Before the show, walk to the Cầu Trần Thị Lý (Thuan Phuoc Bridge) for a stunning, framed photo of the illuminated Dragon Bridge from a distance.

### Schedule



#### 8:00PM – Han River Cruise

Glide along the glittering Han River on a cruise, seeing Da Nang's modern skyline, lit-up bridges (including the Dragon and Love Bridges), and the gentle city life from a tranquil, breezy perspective.

#### Travel Tips

- Bring a light jacket or shawl. It can get surprisingly cool and windy on the water at night.
- Board early to secure a seat on the open-air upper deck for the best views and photos.



#### 9:30PM – Dessert Time (Chè Thái NaNa)

Conclude your first day on a sweet note with a visit to NANA, famous for its Chè Thái—a delightful Thai-inspired dessert soup packed with jellies, tropical fruits, and coconut milk over shaved ice.

#### Travel Tips

- This is a popular local spot for a refreshing evening treat. The desserts are large and often perfect for sharing.
- If you love durian, don't miss their durian dessert option for a truly adventurous end to the meal.

### Schedule



9:00AM – Coffee Time  
(Cửa Ngõ Café)

Begin your discovery of Hoi An at the aptly named "Cửa Ngõ" Café. This charming local spot offers the perfect welcome to the ancient town, serving excellent Vietnamese coffee in a relaxed, authentic atmosphere.

#### Travel Tips

- This café is a favorite among locals and provides a genuine taste of Hoi An's morning rhythm before the tourist crowds arrive. Your guide will assist with ordering.
- Try their traditional cà phê phin (drip coffee) or a refreshing cà phê dừa (coconut coffee) to start your day with classic Vietnamese energy.



10:30AM – Da Nang Museum

Journey back in time at one of Vietnam's most treasured museums. Housing the world's largest collection of Cham Kingdom artifacts, it showcases exquisite sandstone sculptures of deities, monsters, and guardians dating from the 5th to 15th centuries.



#### Travel Tips

- Hire the audio guide or a pocket guidebook at the entrance. The context makes the intricate sculptures far more meaningful.
- The museum is not air-conditioned in all galleries. Visit in the morning to avoid the afternoon heat, and carry water.

**11:30AM – Lunch (Madame Lan Restaurant)**

Enjoy a farewell lunch in Da Nang at the famous Madame Lan Restaurant. Set in a beautiful garden house, it's the perfect place to savor a final feast of Central Vietnamese cuisine in an atmospheric setting.

#### Travel Tips

- A special set menu has been arranged to give you a broad and delicious taste of the region's culinary excellence.
- Don't be shy to ask for seconds of your favorite dishes!



**2:00PM – Water Coconut Boat Riding**

Escape to the serene, green world of the Cam Thanh Coconut Village. Glide in a unique, round bamboo boat through narrow palm-fringed waterways, trying your hand at traditional fishing and enjoying playful spins from the skilled local rowers.

#### Travel Tips

- Wear a hat and sunscreen. You'll be exposed to the sun on the open water.
- Bring small change (20k-50k VND notes) to tip your enthusiastic boat rower, especially if they perform spinning tricks or make you palm-leaf souvenirs.

## Schedule



### 3:30PM – Hoi An Ancient Town

Step into a living postcard. Wander through the UNESCO World Heritage site, where centuries-old merchant houses with mossy yellow walls, ornate assembly halls, and the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge tell tales of a thriving international port.



### Travel Tips

- You need a Hoi An Old Town Ticket to enter the heritage buildings (usually included in tours). Keep it handy as it allows entry to 5 sites.
- The streets get incredibly crowded after 4:30 PM. Visit the indoor sites (like Tan Ky House) first while there are slightly smaller queues.



### 5:30PM – Dinner (Vy's Market Restaurant)

Experience Hoi An's culinary soul at Vy's Market, an interactive "food hall" created by renowned chef Trinh Diem Vy. Sample a wide array of local street food classics from different live cooking stations in one vibrant, fun location.

### Travel Tips

- This is a casual, self-service style meal. Your guide will recommend must-try dishes and explain the various stations.
- This is your best chance to try both of Hoi An's most famous dishes in one place: Cao Lầu noodles and White Rose dumplings.

## Day 2: Hoi An Tour

### Schedule



#### 7:30PM – Lantern Wishing & Boat Riding (Experience)

As dusk falls, Hoi An transforms into a magical fairyland. Purchase a colorful silk lantern, light the candle, and gently set it afloat on the Thu Bồn River, making a wish as it joins a shimmering fleet of lights—an unforgettable, photogenic ritual.

#### Travel Tips

- Buy lanterns from the elderly women sitting along the riverbank with baskets. They are cheaper (around 10k-20k VND) than from shops.
- Be careful with the small candle. Hold the lantern steady until the wax pools, and launch it in a calm spot away from boat traffic.



#### 8:30PM – Back to Da Nang

Relax in a comfortable, air-conditioned transfer after a full and enchanting day, watching the city lights of Danang welcome you back as you reflect on your journey.




#### Travel Tips

- The drive is about 40-60 minutes. It's a good time to nap, organize photos, or check in for any flights the next day.
